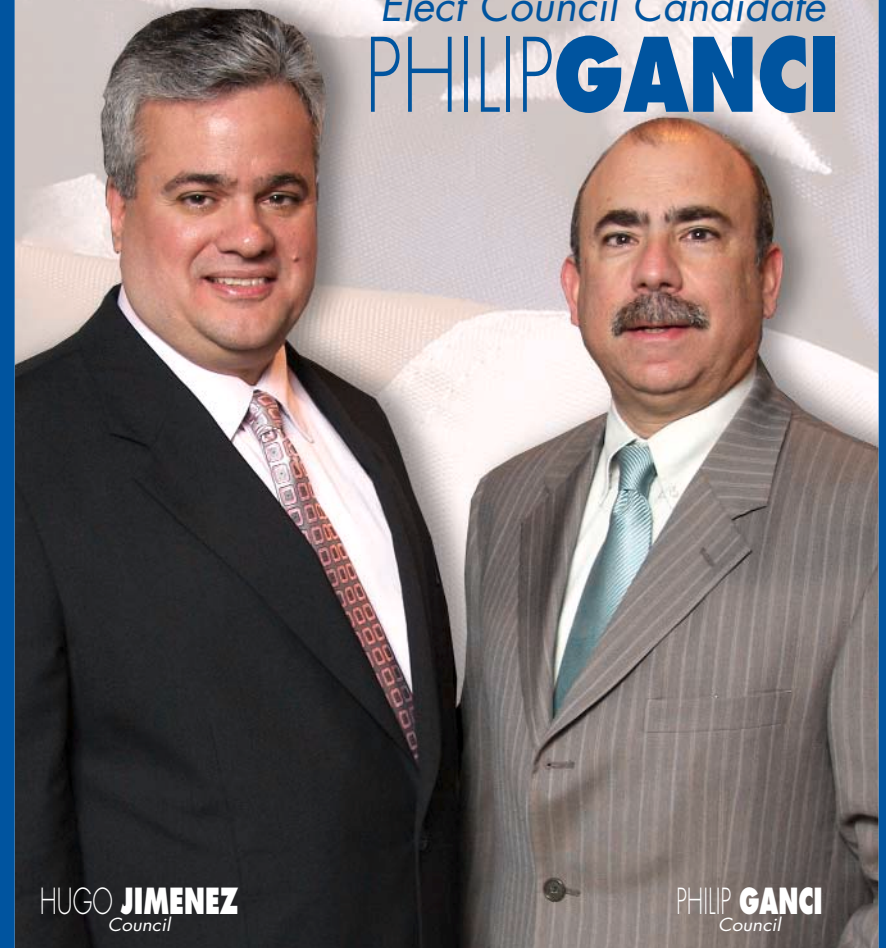
“DEMOCRATIC PLATFORM”

HUGO **JIMENEZ** FOR COUNCIL

Hugo Jimenez is a resident of Ridgefield for over 14 years. He has been married to Nancy for over 25 years and they have two daughters, Barbara and Daisy, both of whom have gone through the Ridgefield school system and graduated from Ridgefield Memorial High School.

After graduating from high school, Hugo joined the US Navy and served from 1981 to 1986. While in the Navy he attended Hospital Corpsmen training and was also trained as a Medical Laboratory

Technician. His last duty station was the Naval Submarine Base in Groton, CT. He has worked in several area hospitals, most currently in the Information Technology Department at New York Presbyterian Hospital. He has a bachelor's degree in chemistry from Farleigh Dickinson University and a master's degree in information systems from the University of Phoenix.

Hugo has served Ridgefield in many volunteer positions, such as a coach and Council member for the RBAO, the Mayor's liaison to the Light Rail project and President of the Ridgefield Democratic Club. Currently he is a member of the Planning Board and was elected Vice Chairman of the Board in January 2009; he is a member of the American Legion Ridgefield Post #221 serving in various positions and was elected Vice-Commander in 2008. In January 2009, he and his wife Nancy were appointed to the Youth Commission.

Hugo's ambition to run for Council is to align with the current Democratic Council members and to make significant changes which will enhance the quality of life in Ridgefield. He feels that during the two and a half years the Republicans have lead the majority they have failed to advance the Overpeck Creek Redevelopment Area; control taxes and spending; and have failed to come up with a viable solution for the Borough Hall building. Hugo wants to make a difference.



PHIL **GANCI** FOR COUNCIL

Phil and his wife Frances have lived in Ridgefield for over 20 years. They have one daughter, Nicole who graduated from Ridgefield Memorial High School in 2005. She received her undergraduate degree from Fordham University in 2008 and is attending Law School in the fall of 2009.

years ago, Phil started an insurance brokerage and risk management company, which he still owns and operates today.

Phil has dedicated much of his time to the town of Ridgefield. For the past 3 years, he has served as a member of the Board of Education and was recently chosen as chairman of finance. He was instrumental in putting together the school budget of 2009-2010 which kept school taxes stable this year and at the same time putting money into capital improvements of school facilities. He has worked as a school board member to make important strides in the education of our town's children. Additionally, he is currently a member of the Planning Board and has been so for over 6 years. In this position he was instrumental in creating the town's first redevelopment plan and is dedicated to seeing its completion.

Phil is running for Council because he is frustrated with the political statement in town and wants to put citizens first and eliminate the current climate of political agendas and impasse. He will focus on relieving the tax burden of the residents. He looks forward to putting the wants and needs of the residents of Ridgefield first as opposed to the present Republican majority.
